- 1. Explain how Louie Zamperini's career as a child scofflaw contributed to his success in surviving WWII.
- 2. Analyze how the Japanese notions of racial superiority combined with the Japanese "culture of honor" contributed to the treatment of POW's during WWII.
- 3. How and why does Louie manage to escape the downed aircraft that was on the rescue missing to Palmyra? To what forces does Louie later attribute his escape?

 Discuss/entertain other explanations for his escape

- 4. Explain how and why a choice of attitude may have contributed to the survival of 2 of the men on the life raft and the death of the 3rd man on the life raft in the Pacific Ocean.
- 5. Explain how both cultural, educational and military indoctrination of Japanese soldiers made it likely that each soldier would rather fight to the death than be captured and held as a POW.
- 6. Explain how the advancement of the military career of Mutsuhiro Watanabe may have contributed to his attitude towards and treatment of prisoners in his camps and particularly his treatment of Louie Zamperini.
- 7. Louie refuses the opportunity to become an "enemy propagandist" (pg 266-267) and therefore suffers even more when he is returned to the POW camps. In your opinion, why did he do so, and what would you have done in a similar situation & why? Was Louie's decision foolish or heroic? Explain.
