## COUNSELOR'S CORNER

Fall is here and that's college and technical school application season! We have been busy planning for the future.

Here are some updates and information.

#### Junior Classroom Meetings:

I will be meeting with Juniors on Monday, October 30 to distribute their transcripts and teach them how to calculate their overall GPA and TOPS GPA. Please ask them to share the document with you. Juniors will also spend time exploring career and college websites.

A representative from LOSFA was here at Notre Dame during the College Fair and for a parent meeting on 10/23. We will have another meeting in March 2024. Remember, to obtain TOPS funds, students must also meet required ACT scores. I suggest juniors register for upcoming national ACT exams.

#### **Senior Meetings:**

Seniors were given their TOPS University transcript with their TOPS CORE GPA. Group sessions will continue to be offered during lunch periods for seniors to receive assistance with college applications. Scholarships, deadlines, and other pertinent information is shared with Seniors 2024 via my Google Classroom. Encourage your student to visit with me if they need assistance with their college applications. I am here during lunch or before and after school to assist them. They need only email with the request.

#### **All Grade Levels:**

You can create an account with LOSFA via the Student Hub for students planning to attend a technical or community college or university. It's an online system to help students track their TOPS status while in high school and throughout the student's college career. Go to https://www.osfa.la.gov/studenthub.html to create an account. Freshman will not have any grades available as of yet in this account. It's never too early to learn about college and technical school programs.
