## **Create your TOPS Student Hub Account!**

LOSFA's Student Hub is a way for parents and students to track a student's award eligibility and status. This applies to all grade levels. Create your TOPS tracking account at the LOSFA Student Hub to keep track of your TOPS Scholarship qualification! https://www.mylosfa.la.gov

Important: When creating your account use your SSN# for the LASECID!

### **ACT TEST DATES**

April 13 The last ACT a student can take to be eligible for TOPS AND receive all 8 semesters of funding.

June 8 Can receive TOPS if a qualifying score is earned but will be penalized one semester of funds.

July 13 Can receive TOPS if a qualifying score is earned but will be penalized one semester of funds.

Please make every effort to attend College Night with your student. College admissions has changed over the years, and it's important to understand the process.
